You will need a credit card to pay for the music. This is properly licensed music. I will show you how to transfer the format so as it can be played on home audio music players, and also on your MP3 players.

The other requirement is Windows Media Player Version 11 for Vista. Version 10 or 11 for XP, and Version 9 for anything lower. Also a broadband internet connection is advisable.

The music downloads in WMA format which is 1/3 smaller than the compression with MP3. It is the same quality.

Windows Media Player has the rights management (DRM). This means that the licenses are automatically activated when you play the song for the first time on your **computer**. If you are using Mozilla Firefox or any other Browser the music has to be played over the Internet to activate the License.

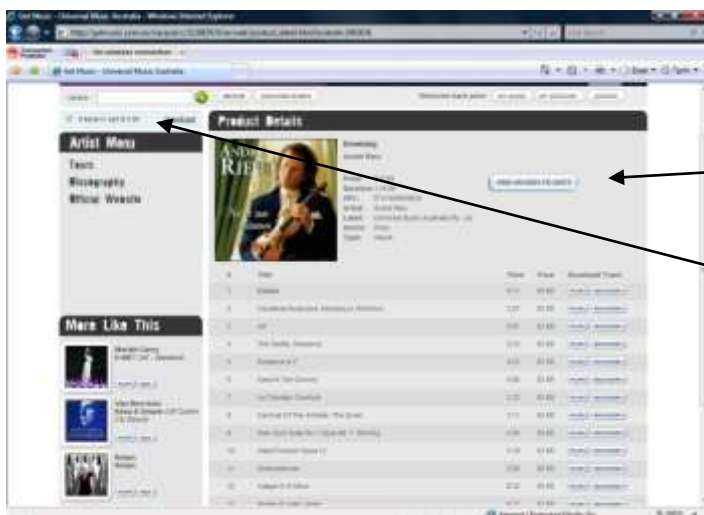
O.K. lets' go to our music site.

Go to your Music site. I use "www.getmusic.com.au"



If you are visiting for the first time you must sign-up and get a password. This must be done and an email will be sent to you confirming this act. It is a safety precaution.

Once you are signed-up, and ready to go, enter some details of what you are looking for in the Search Box, or just browse around.



I entered Andre Rieu – Dreaming CD

Click "Add to album cart" button.

In the top left hand side of the page the item will appear near a shopping trolley together with the price.

Click the "checkout" button



You will be taken to a screen as the one opposite. Notice there is a warning stating that the music is in WMA format. This is because this format can only be played on a computer. Don't worry about that.

Click the Pay Now Button or go on shopping if you wish.



When you come to the payment page you must be very careful to ensure that the padlock in the address bar is locked. This is your security.

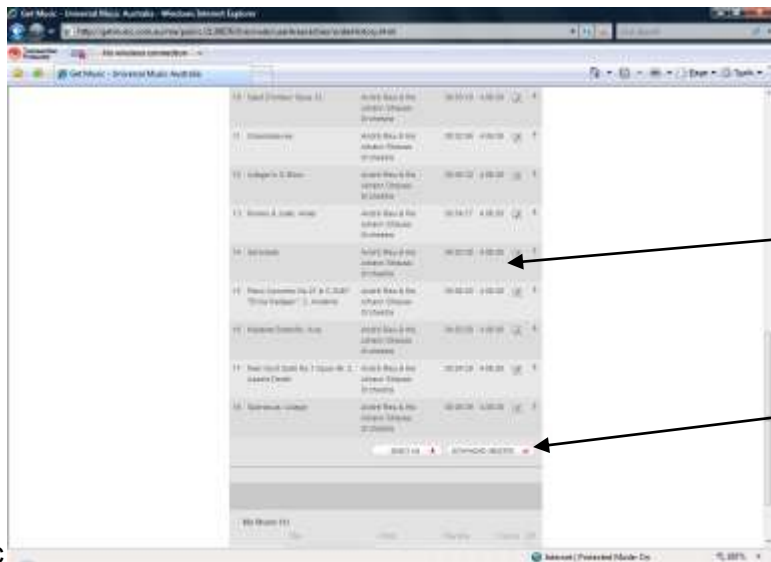
Click the type of credit card you wish to use and proceed with payment.



The next page acknowledges the payment and gives a Merchant Number and Transaction ID.

Take a copy of these.

There is a button on this page "My Music". Click the button that is where your music is stored waiting for you.



Our music is now ready for download. You will be asked where to download this too. Choose a folder on your computer.

Click on the tracks you wish to download. There is no need to download all at once; they will just sit in your music waiting for you.

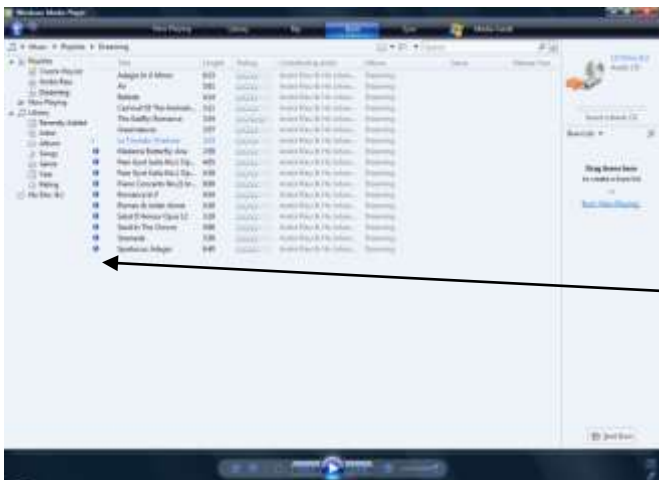
Click the download selected button.

These files take a little while to download.

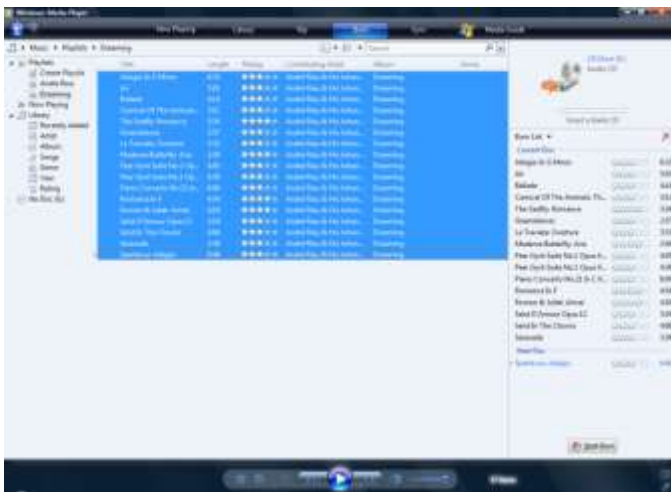

The music will arrive in the file which you selected to download it too. It will be in a WinZip form, which has to be unzipped.

Now transfer your music to Windows Media Player. Place into a Playlist (to keep it tidy).



You will notice "blue dots" on the left hand side of some of the songs. These are the Licenses. You must play the music through your computer in order to activate the License. As you play the music so the "dots" will disappear.



When all the Licenses have been activated, highlight the songs and drag to the right hand side of the window.

Insert a CD and click the Start Burn button.

This will burn in Audio for your home player.
