

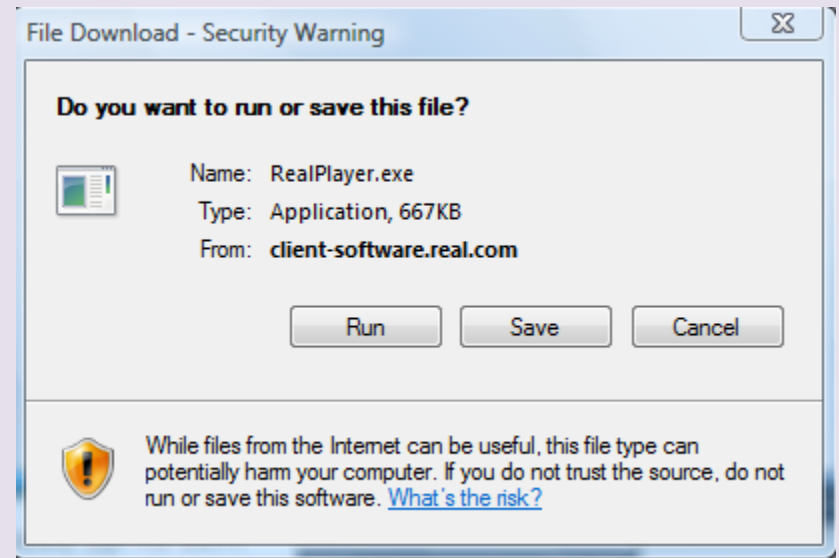


Getting there

The following window will appear.



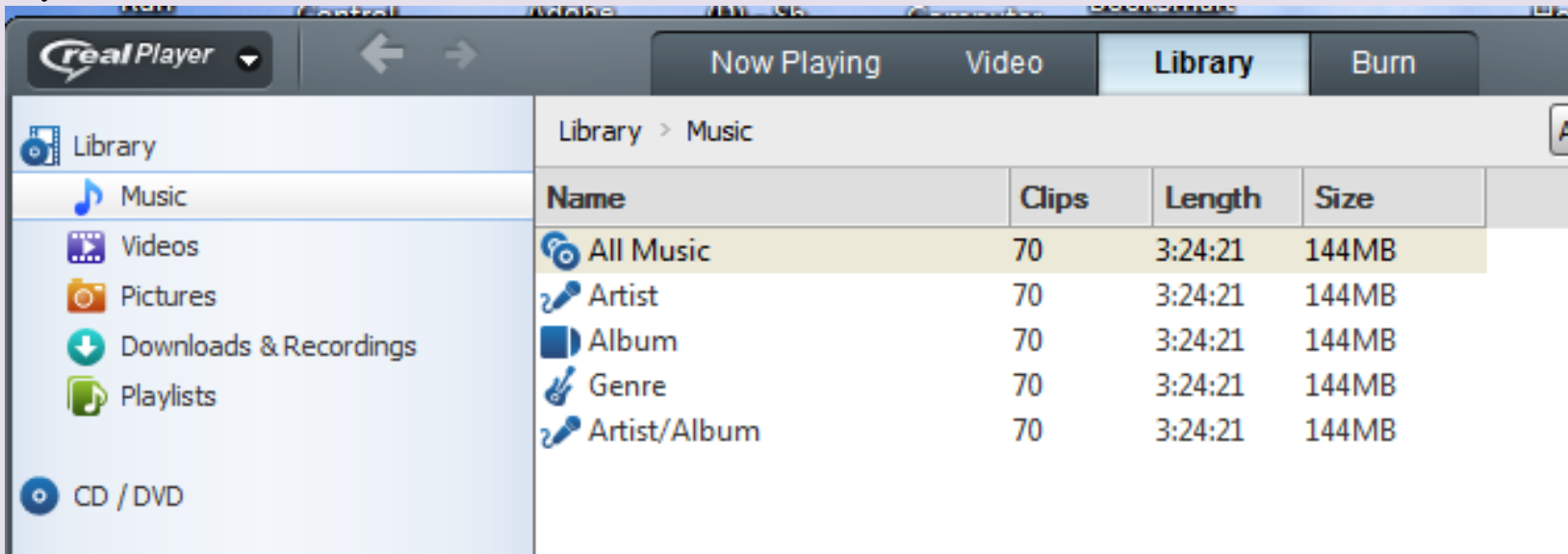


Real Player will open In the paid version - You will be offered plenty of Freebies but they will not last, you will be asked to pay. You are basically allowed to download music, videos, burn CD's and DVD's convert music to other formats, and what I consider to be really useful – cut the music from a Video to play on an MP3 or iTunes player even a cell phone or blackberry.

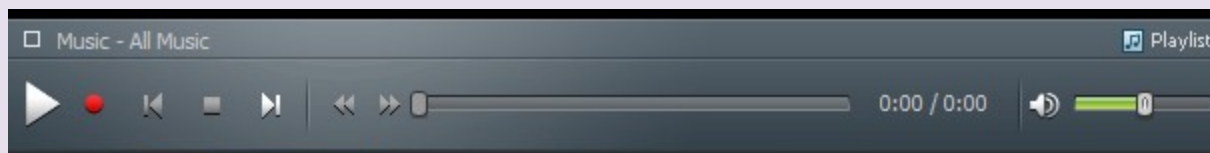

On the top toolbar you will mostly use Library. From here you can open all your folders, in Music, Videos and so forth.

Setting up a few Preferences.

We need to set up a couple of basic preferences.

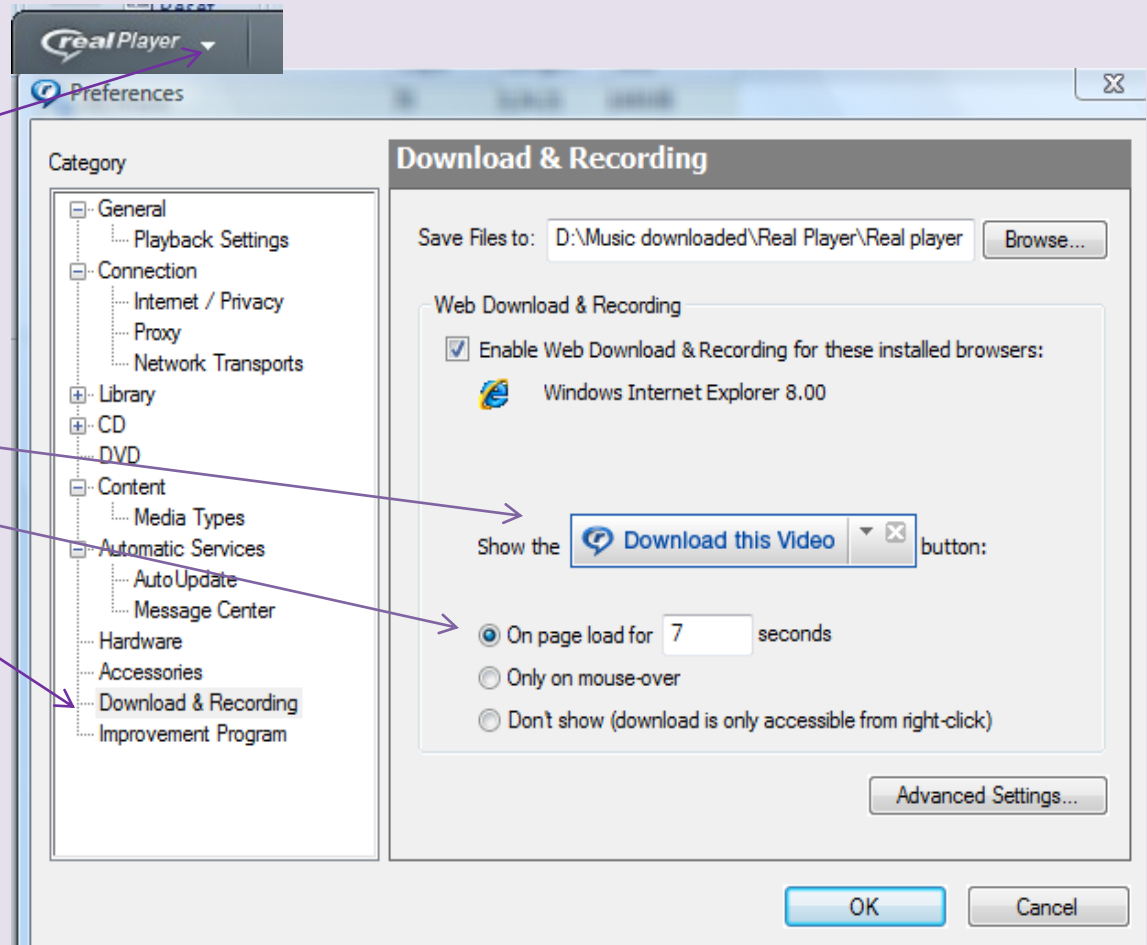
Open the Preferences window by clicking on the arrow next to the Icon.

Go to Downloading and Recording.

The Bar “Download this Video” tick on the page load and set the number of seconds to see the bar.

This Bar will appear whenever you open a video which can be downloaded from the internet. Just click the Bar - down will come the video, and go into the correct folder.


You can also choose where to save your music and videos in the Save Files to box.



At this point I should stress you need a Broadband connection for downloading videos.



Let's get some music

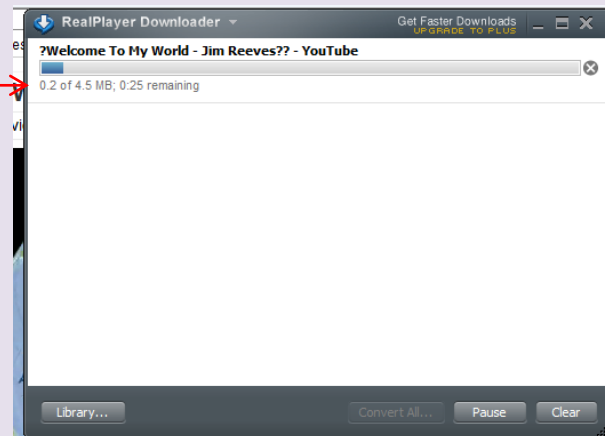
Close down Real Player and open the Internet. In the address bar type  You will find music to suit every taste . Some of the really old favourites that we never hear any more, plenty of classical including videos of Andre Rieu's concerts. Strauss, Mozart and so on. There is plenty of choice.

In the search box, type the name of a song or an Artist.


You will be presented with a host of music. These days it is all on .flv (flash video) I chose the one opposite. I hope it does not show my age too much. The most important thing here is to click the Download button quickly.

A box will appear showing the download.

Where too from here?



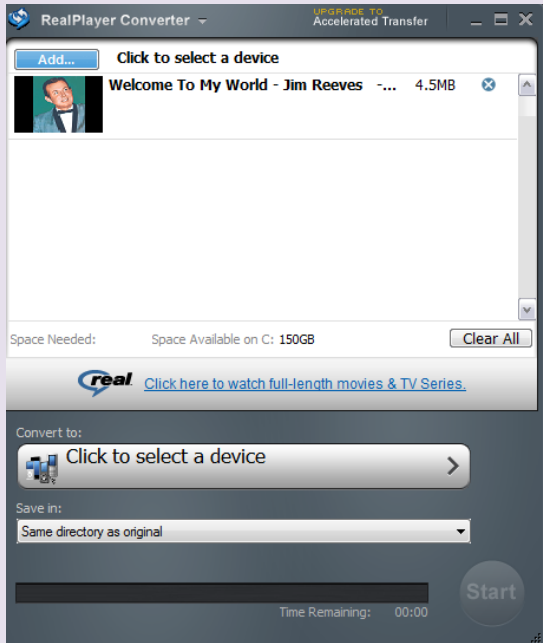

Let's convert our file

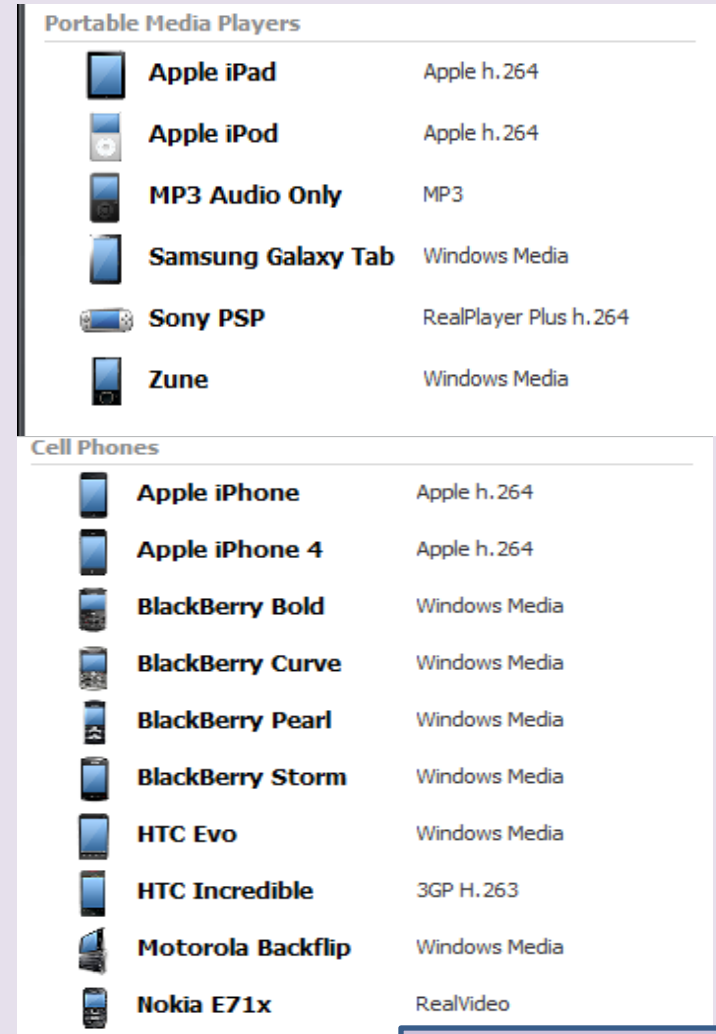
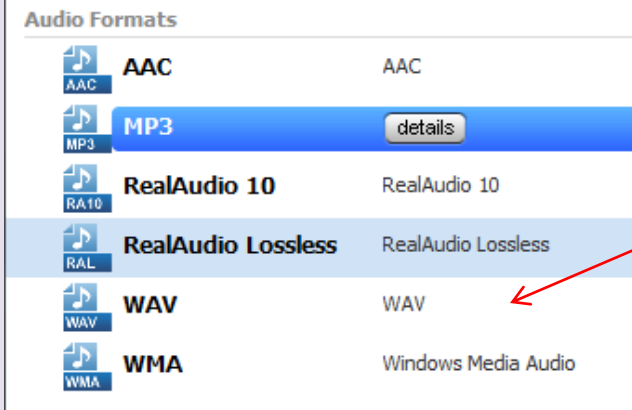


Click on Select a Device.

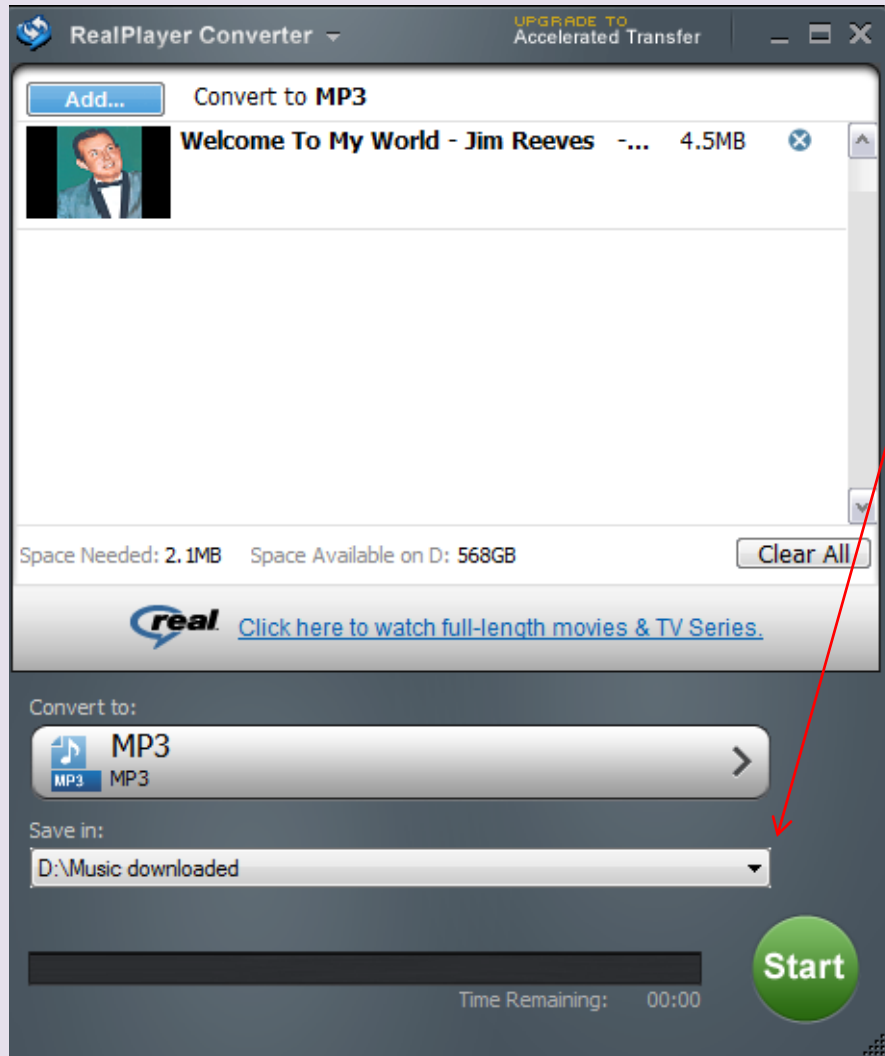
The layouts opposite will show you just a part of what we can use.

For those of you attending the ecard sessions we will need to use WAV to embed our music into our card.



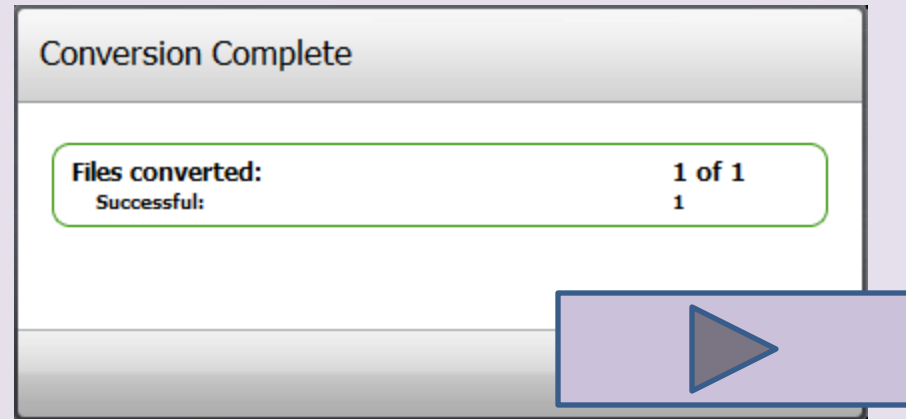
We have selected our Device MP3

We have already chosen MP3. Now go to Save in: and choose where to store the music file.

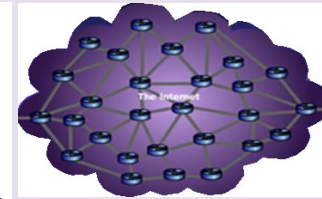
Click Start. A window will appear when completed.

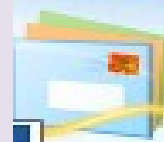
