

Rescue Disk Windows 7

Since we no longer get a system recovery disc with our Operating systems it is very important to make our own. It's a trend that has been unfortunately phased out over the years. A system recovery disc is your only resource if your system ever becomes unbootable, so it's essential that you make your own using a blank DVD. Do not fear it's a fairly straightforward process.

Now click Start and type "Repair" in the Search Box. Select "Create a System Repair Disc". Insert a blank DVD in your DVD/CD burner. From there, simply follow the instructions on your screen, label the disk and keep it in a safe place.



This disk includes a variety of recovery and diagnostic tools and also allows you to choose a System Restore point to bring your Computer back to its last functioning status. So, if you come across any computer trouble, fret not; just boot your system with the repair disc.
