

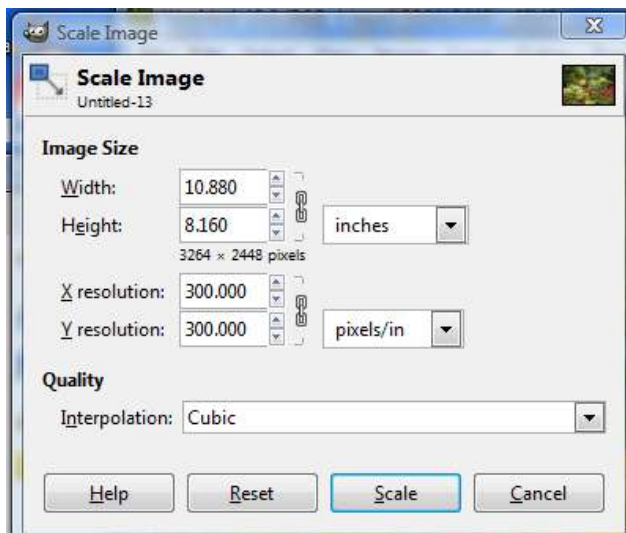
Resizing an image using Gimp 2.6.8

Open the program Gimp 2.6.8

Go to File/Open – locate the photo/picture you wish to resize, Click Open

Once the photo has opened make a duplicate (never work with your original):

Go to Image on the toolbar/Duplicate. Close the original and work with the duplicate.



On the toolbar go to Image/Scale image.

The box opposite will appear. This shows the current size of the photo and the pixels per inch.

Change the Width box to the desired size. Click in the Height box, which will then change automatically.

Remember it is not a good idea to try making the picture larger, only smaller.

Click Scale.

Save the picture as a jpg. It is now ready for use as you wish.
